Introduction

Welcome to Chevening Parish, we hope you will be very happy here and feel a part of our community.

This document is provided by the Parish Council to introduce new residents to the range of services and activities that are available in the parish or nearby. The parish stretches from the top of the hill above Chevening village and St Botolph's church in the north to Ide Hill village in the south and from the M25 junction to Witches Lane (where Amherst School is located). We are a Parish with 3 Churches. 5 pubs but no shops. Please note that the businesses mentioned in this pack are for information and in no way form recommendations from the Parish Council

A communication section has been included to give details of other, helpful local publications and resources.

To start you off here are a few key things that may prove useful straight away:

- Bins are collected weekly. To view your collection day go to https://selfservice.sevenoaks.gov.uk/do-it-online/ufsmain?formid=REFUSE COLLECTIONS&ebz=1 159422 1798290&ebd=0&ebz=1 1594221798290
- Recycling SDC provides black bin bags for household rubbish and clear bin bags for recycling plastic, paper, etc. Glass must be recycled at the bottle banks around the district, such as in Tesco's car park in Riverhead.
- Garden Waste Is collected fortnightly

- The A25 section in our parish is extremely busy every day at school drop off and collection times 8 to 9:30am and 3 to 4.30pm. Best avoided if possible.
- There is a **Minor Injuries** Unit at Sevenoaks Hospital that is open from 8am to 8pm every day. It has an X ray machine and treats simple injuries and burns.

- sprains and strains
- minor head injuries
- cuts and grazes
- bites and stings
- minor scalds and burns
- ear and throat infections
- eye problems

Defibrillators

There are currently 6 defibrillators in Chevening Parish and 2 others nearby.

- Recreation Ground on Chevening Road, TN13 2SA; secured to the front wall of the pavilion and available 24/7.
- Chipstead Common (on the wall of the Football Hut facing Barnfield Road and available 24/7
- Chesterfield Drive (overlooking the lake) and available 24/7
- Bullfinch Pub on London Road, Riverhead, TN13 2DR, available during the pub's opening hours.
- George & Dragon (during opening hours)
- Chipstead Sailing Club is open in their clubhouse.
- Tesco's, Aisher Way, Riverhead, TN13 2QS,
- Riverhead Village Hall, Amherst Hill, TN13 2EL

These are all portable and the machine will talk you through the steps necessary to use it. Please note that manual chest compressions should be started immediately and only be stopped temporarily when the machine tells you not to touch the person in distress and to move away from them so that the required shock can be given


Minibus
